*(Some Medical Colleges require only one semester of Calculus and Statistics. To be competitive, a full year of Calculus is recommended.)

Admission to medical college is extremely competitive, and with few exceptions, a bachelor's degree is required. Students may major in any area as long as they complete the pre-requisite admissions requirements. Selection for medical school admissions is based on the following:

1. Undergraduate record, including number of units completed each semester (Note: Students are expected to be successful in 17 units or more per semester), breadth of coursework completed, grade point average both general and science prerequisites (Note: The average G.P.A. is 3.5 and higher).
2. MCAT - Scores on the Medical College Admissions Test.
3. Letters of recommendation.
4. Life experiences including volunteer work both general and in a medical environment, research and additional activities in college or the community.
