The Associate in Arts for Transfer Degree in Social Justice Studies, also called the Social Justice Studies AA-T Degree, prepares students to transfer to CSU campuses that offer bachelor's degrees in Gender Studies; Sociology – Concentration Race, Class and Gender; Critical Race, Gender and Sexuality Studies; Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies; and Women's Studies. This degree requires students complete 60 CSU transferable units, including completion of CSU GE or IGETC and 18-19 units in the major with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better. Title 5 requires that students earn a grade of "C" or better in all major coursework.

Note: It is strongly recommended that students meet with a Fullerton College counselor to review the AA-T requirements.

To receive your AA-T degree, you will need to complete a Fullerton College graduation application and turn it in to Admissions and Records by the graduation application deadline.
