Administration of Justice Associate in Science Degree for Transfer, also called the Administration of Justice AS-T Degree, prepares students to transfer to CSU campuses that offer bachelor's degrees in Criminal Justice. This degree requires students complete 60 CSU transferable units, including completion of CSU GE or IGETC and 18-19 units in the major and electives with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better. Title 5 requires that students earn a grade of "C" or better in all major coursework.

Note: It is strongly recommended that students meet with a Fullerton College counselor to review the AS-T requirements.

To receive your AS-T degree, you will need to complete a Fullerton College graduation application and turn it in to Admissions and Records by the graduation application deadline.
