Early Childhood Education Associate in Science Degree, also called the ECE AS-T, prepares students to transfer to CSU campuses that offer bachelor's degrees in Early Childhood Education. This degree requires students complete 60 CSU transferable units, including completion of CSU GE or IGETC and 24 units in the major with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better. Title 5 requires that students earn a grade of "C" or better in all major coursework.

**Note: It is strongly recommended that students meet with a Fullerton College counselor to review the AS-T requirements.**
