The Associate in Arts in Elementary Teacher Education for Transfer Degree, also called the Elementary Teacher Education AA-T Degree, prepares students to transfer to CSU campuses that offer bachelor's degrees in Liberal Studies or Integrated Teacher Education Programs. This degree requires students complete 60 CSU transferable units, including completion of CSU GE or IGETC and 54-57 units in the major with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better. Title 5 requires that students earn a grade of "C" or better in all major coursework.

**Note: It is strongly recommended that students meet with a Fullerton College counselor to review the AA-T requirements.**
