The Associate in Arts in English for Transfer Degree, also called the English AA-T Degree, prepares students to transfer to CSU campuses that offer bachelor's degrees in English. English AA-T degree prepares students to read and write about literature critically and to understand key historical and generic influences in the production and reception of literature and other cultural texts. This degree requires students complete 60 CSU transferable units, including completion of CSU GE or IGETC and 19 units in the major with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better. Title 5 requires that students earn a grade of "C" or better in all major coursework.

Note: It is strongly recommended that students meet with a Fullerton College counselor to review the AA-T requirements.

To receive your AA-T degree, you will need to complete a Fullerton College graduation application and turn it in to Admissions and Records by the graduation application deadline.
